

Why Should a Church Practice Church Discipline?

1 Corinthians 5:1-13 NIV

It is actually reported that there is sexual immorality among you, and of a kind that does not occur even among pagans: A man has his father's wife.² And you are proud! Shouldn't you rather have been filled with grief and have put out of your fellowship the man who did this?³ Even though I am not physically present, I am with you in spirit. And I have already passed judgment on the one who did this, just as if I were present.⁴ When you are assembled in the name of our Lord Jesus and I am with you in spirit, and the power of our Lord Jesus is present,⁵ hand this man over to Satan, so that the sinful nature may be destroyed and his spirit saved on the day of the Lord.⁶ Your boasting is not good. Don't you know that a little yeast works through the whole batch of dough?⁷ Get rid of the old yeast that you may be a new batch without yeast--as you really are. For Christ, our Passover lamb, has been sacrificed.⁸ Therefore let us keep the Festival, not with the old yeast, the yeast of malice and wickedness, but with bread without yeast, the bread of sincerity and truth.⁹ I have written you in my letter not to associate with sexually immoral people--¹⁰ not at all meaning the people of this world who are immoral, or the greedy and swindlers, or idolaters. In that case you would have to leave this world.¹¹ But now I am writing you that you must not associate with anyone who calls himself a brother but is sexually immoral or greedy, an idolater or a slanderer, a drunkard or a swindler. With such a man do not even eat.¹² What business is it of mine to judge those outside the church? Are you not to judge those inside?¹³ God will judge those outside. "Expel the wicked man from among you."

With this passage in mind, we understand that:

We have Paul writing under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit and *commanding* that an unrepentant sinner, engaged in an openly observable sin, must be expelled from fellowship in the local church.

This is the message we have heard from him and declare to you: God is light; in him there is no darkness at all. ⁶ If we claim to have fellowship with him yet walk in the darkness, we lie and do not live by the truth. ⁷ But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, purifies us from all sin. ⁸ If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us. ⁹ If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.

But the cowardly, the unbelieving, the vile, the murderers, the sexually immoral, those who practice magic arts, the idolaters and all liars--their place will be in the fiery lake of burning sulfur. This is the second death."

Among them are Hymenaeus and Philetus, ¹⁸ who have wandered away from the truth.

All this is Why it is Extremely Important to execute Church Discipline.

Expulsion of the Openly Sinful, Unrepentant Person is Necessary (and Commanded):

- To Maintain the Witness of the Local Church
- To Expose the Sin and Deal with it Properly
- To Warn People about God's Judgment
- AND, to Protect the Rest of the Church from the Yeast, Bad Apple and Gangrene!
